## Retail center lands urgent care center, outlines timeline for Triad's first Habit Burger

A Triad urgent care partnership will open another local office in a recently completed shopping center.

Novant Health-GoHealth soon will move into a 2,400-square-foot space at Peace Haven Village, the new Publix-anchored shopping center in Clemmons, according to <u>Darrell Palasciano</u>, a broker with The Shopping Center Group.

GoHealth will share an outparcel building with Mattress Warehouse along Lewisville-Clemmons Road.

In October, <u>Triad Business Journal reported that Novant would</u> partner with <u>GoHealth</u>, which has similar partnerships in at least six other states.

This month, Novant Health-GoHealth locations opened at 7811 North Point Blvd. and 600 Highland Oaks Drive in Winston-Salem, and at 111 Gateway Center Drive in Kernersville. Another Winston-Salem site is "opening soon" at 50-C Miller St. The partnership also has two locations in Charlotte and one in Matthews.

Palasciano also told TBJ that The Habit Burger, an upscale burger chain based in California, was expected to open a 3,000-square-foot, freestanding restaurant on an outparcel between Panera Bread and Novant Health-GoHealth, in late May. He said Venture Construction Co., based in Norcross, Georgia, with a division office in Greensboro, would be the general contractor.

TBJ was first to report last February that Habit Burger had signed to open its first Triad location at Peace Haven Village. No Habit Burger restaurants are open in the state, but a location on South Kings

Drive in Charlotte is listed by the chain as "coming soon."
